To Supervisors

QRME will conduct the Annual General Meeting after the RDAQ conference this year. At this meeting, Board Directors will be elected as the usual 2 year term draws to a close. Dr. Simon Hosking has filled the position as the Supervisors nominee for two terms.

Nominations are sought for the position of Supervisor nominee to the QRME Board for a two year term. We are very eager to have Supervisor nominees who are currently supervising QRME, Registrars, Residents (on PGPPP) or medical students; or Supervisors whose practices are currently accredited with QRME even if the practice doesn't have a placement this term. Principle and Co-Supervisors are welcome to be nominated. You are invited to nominate up to two (2) candidates, which may include yourself, to be considered for the next two (2) year term at the AGM in June.

Board membership entails four face to face meetings and four teleconferences a year and occasional representation of the company. Board members may become involved in meetings with GPET, Colleges and Divisions, representation at conferences and selection of Registrars. The role is generously remunerated based on time contributed and some of the more senior roles also attract a stipend. All travel and accommodation costs are covered by QRME. All new Board members are given an orientation, then have an annual professional development allowance which they are encouraged to use on familiarising with rural medical education and governance.

We therefore ask that you carefully consider nominating a supervisor to the Board of QRME to fill this upcoming vacancy.
